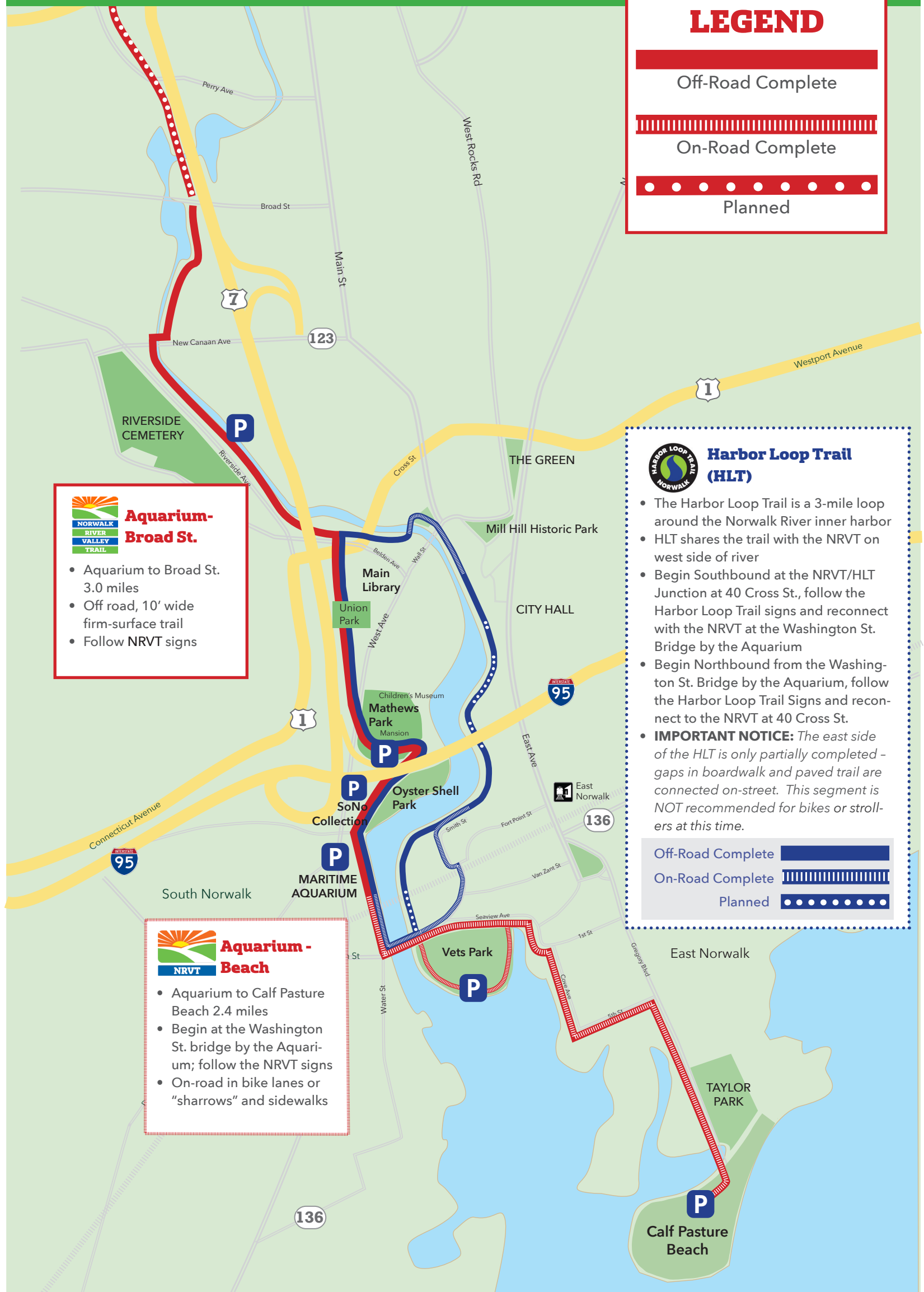

The Norwalk River Valley Trail (NRVT) will be a 10-foot-wide, multi-use, universally accessible, 30-mile trail from Norwalk to Danbury.

Aquarium-Broad St.

- Aquarium to Broad St. 3.0 miles
- Off road, 10' wide firm-surface trail
- Follow NRVT signs

Aquarium-Beach

- Aquarium to Calf Pasture Beach 2.4 miles
- Begin at the Washington St. bridge by the Aquarium; follow the NRVT signs
- On-road in bike lanes or "sharrows" and sidewalks

Harbor Loop Trail (HLT)

- The Harbor Loop Trail is a 3-mile loop around the Norwalk River inner harbor
- HLT shares the trail with the NRVT on west side of river
- Begin Southbound at the NRVT/HLT Junction at 40 Cross St., follow the Harbor Loop Trail signs and reconnect with the NRVT at the Washington St. Bridge by the Aquarium
- Begin Northbound from the Washington St. Bridge by the Aquarium, follow the Harbor Loop Trail Signs and reconnect to the NRVT at 40 Cross St.
- **IMPORTANT NOTICE:** The east side of the HLT is only partially completed - gaps in boardwalk and paved trail are connected on-street. This segment is NOT recommended for bikes or strollers at this time.
